Field Surveys: Field surveys are a method of collecting data by physically visiting a specific location or area. They are used to collect data about the property on which a construction project will take place, and or the existing features of a building. This data includes the property's boundaries, contours, existing features, and utilities. The surveyor who conducts the field survey uses this data to produce a map of the property. Field surveys are also used by researchers and master students for the process of primary data collection
